The Board met with Frosty Greenfield, Shoshone County Public Works Director, at 9:15 a.m. to discuss, review and consider the Benewah County and Shoshone County St. Joe River Road Western Federal Lands Grant. A motion was made by Commissioner Fitzgerald, seconded by Commissioner Huber to approve the Memorandum of Understanding Between Benewah County and Shoshone County for the St. Joe River Road Pavement Rehabilitation, MP 0 to MP 35 – Western Federal Lands Grant, as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board met with Tim Read, Mineral County, Montana Planner, Roman Zylawy, Mineral County Commissioner, Denley Loge, Mineral County, Montana Representative, Shoshone County Assessor Jerry White, and Shoshone County Assessor Mapper Nancy Hoiland at 1:00 p.m. to discuss and review the Lookout Ski Resort Idaho, Montana State boundary line. Mr. Read stated that the state line was established in 1904 and that the boundary line has changed and they are trying to correct the situation which takes a federal mandate. Information was passed out from the United States Department of the Interior regarding a formal opinion as to how the state line between Idaho and Montana would be retraced in the Look Out Pass area and a Memorandum of Legal Advice from the Montana Department of Revenue addressing the question can Montana and Mineral County tax portions of the Lookout Pass Ski Resort which appear to be in Montana. The ski resort expansion prompted the inquiry and research that has been done by Mineral County. Commissioner Fitzgerald stated that there are four (4) components to this: 1) technical component; 2) legal component; 3) property owner/Lookout Ski Resort involvement; and 4) the process to get it done. Following further discussion and review, Commissioner Fitzgerald stated they would take the information presented under review with another meeting to be scheduled in the future.
