The following proceedings were had to-wit:

The Board met with Keisha Oxendine, Shoshone County Prosecuting Attorney at 9:00 a.m. in Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206(f). The Board adjourned from Executive Session with no decision to be made in open session.

The Board convened at 9:30 a.m. and the meeting was called to order. Peggy White Shoshone County Clerk, Frosty Greenfield Shoshone County Public Works Director, and Matt Beehner were also in attendance. The consent agenda was reviewed for consideration as follows:

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Consideration and Decision of the Minutes of the Commissioners' Public Agenda Session dated Monday, December 4 to Friday, December 8, 2017. The review and decision on these minutes was moved to the consent agenda for next week.
- 2. PERSI Buyout Road Department. A motion was made by Commissioner Hansen, seconded by Commissioner Fitzgerald to pull this item out for separate discussion. The motion carried unanimously. Commissioner Fitzgerald stated that the original decision on this PERSI buyout that was made by the Board on November 28, 2017 is declared void because the criteria was not met for an emergency meeting under Idaho Code. Items discussed on the buyout included the following:
 - Peggy White stated that with this buyout, it needs to go through County payroll which involves a tax component 7.6% in the amount of \$2,680.68.
 - The Board believes there is sufficient funding and cost saving in the current Public Works budget to cover the buyout. This employee position will not be filled and a part-time, non benefitted employee will be hired. This along with the savings from the current lack of snow/costs will support the buyout.
 - Matt Beehner expressed his concerns with the buyout stating the Board does not have any idea of the financial impact, he does not see any savings, it is a benefit to one person, and they are setting precedence.

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Important items for the buyout: December 15th – notify PERSI, employee returns paperwork to PERSI, payment to PERSI by December 21st. Peggy stated that the funds can be directly wired to PERSI. Legal can prepare an Agreement with the employee receiving the benefit on the purpose of the buyout and the employee's separation from employment.

Following discussion and review, a motion was made by Commissioner Hansen, seconded by Commissioner Huber to approve the buyout amount of \$35,041.52 effective December 15th along with the payroll tax amount of \$2,680.68. The motion carried unanimously.
