2018 Tax Exemption

Those in attendance: Commission Chairman Mike Fitzgerald, Commissioner John Hansen, Commissioner Jay Huber, Deputy Clerk Susan Hendrixson, and Attorney Jason Mau via conference call, Administrator of Silverwood Good Samaritan Michael Newbauer, and Shoshone County Assessor Jerry White. Michael Newbauer and Jason Mau were sworn in to present testimony. The hearing was turned over to Jason Mau who stated that the value is not being appealed. The owner is appealing the Board of Commissioners' decision denying the Society's religious property tax exemption under Idaho Code 63-602B. He stated the Society is entitled to a 100% religious property tax exemption under this section of the code and at the very least to a partial tax exemption for the portions of its property dedicated to religious use and the portions of its facility used for these purposes. Currently 4,365 square feet of its 36,564 square foot skilled nursing and assisted living facility, approximately 12% are used for these purposes. The Society does not have a profit motive, nor does it generate a profit from its religious service. Ada County and Latah counties have granted a partial exemption on their facilities. Jerry White stated that he was not opposed to a partial exemption on this property. The Board asked several questions of both Mr. Mau and Mr. Newbauer regarding the facility. Following review and discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Huber, seconded by Commissioner Hansen, to table the decision for further information to Monday, July 9th. The motion carried unanimously.

2018 Tax Exemption

Those in attendance: Commission Chairman Mike Fitzgerald, Commissioner John Hansen, Commissioner Jay Huber, Deputy Clerk Susan Hendrixson, Shoshone County Assessor Jerry White, Appraiser Chris Perry, Carey and Mark Schram. Carey and Mark Schram were sworn in to present testimony.

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The hearing was turned over to Carey to present her case. The value is not being appealed, she is appealing the Board of Commissioners' decision denying Christian Life Center tax exemption under Idaho Code 63-602B. Carey stated that there doesn't seem to be any mention of vacancy being a deterrent from tax exemption. Mike Fitzgerald stated that ID Code states that the property is being used exclusively for, which at this time it is not in use or connected with religious, educational or recreational purposes or activities at the time of assessment. Following review and discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Hansen, seconded by Commissioner Huber to uphold the original denial for tax exemption for 2018. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board convened at 1:30 p.m. and the meeting was called to order. Also in attendance was Colleen Rosson, Director of the Silver Valley Economic Development Corporation, and Jon Bell. The consent agenda was reviewed for consideration as follows:
