- Tamie Eberhard met with Natalie Chiles this past spring and reviewed the status of the County accounts. The County is waiting for a Frontier traffic study report to determine current usage.
- The County currently does not have any extra replacement phones or handsets. The cost of the replacements through Frontier is: 1-8528 Mitel is \$118.40, and 1-8568 Mitel Telephone is \$188.80.
- Natalie suggested looking for refurbished telephone and handset replacements online it would be more cost effective.
- Tamie needs two (2) conference phones for District Court that are \$583.20 each. These phones would need to be programmed into the system at \$125.00 per hour since we don't have an extended warranty. Since the County does not have an extended warranty, we are not receiving any system software updates.
- The current system was purchased in 2011 and the system and equipment are becoming obsolete, and the County should consider working on upgrading the system.
- The next step is to review the Frontier traffic study report to determine what the County is utilizing and where the County can save.

## **RESOLUTION 2019-49**

# A RESOLUTION SETTING THE FEES FOR RETAIL ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSES FOR 2020

WHEREAS, the Session Laws of 1947 of the State of Idaho, as set forth in Chapter 274 of the 1947 Section Laws, authorized the retail sale of liquor by the drink in Shoshone County and incorporated cities; and

WHEREAS, the law provides in addition to a State license, the County is authorized and empowered to license the sale of liquor by the drink and is entitled to receive as a license fee, twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount of the license fee collected by the Commission of Law Enforcement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Shoshone County, hereby authorize the sale of liquor by the drink within Shoshone County and the incorporated cities of the County and that any licensee, who has obtained a license from the State of Idaho, in an incorporated city to sell liquor by the drink must also obtain a County license; that the license fee for the amount collected by the Commissioner of Law Enforcement for the State of Idaho; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before a County license will be granted, the applicant must make out an application for the County license showing:

1ST: That he has obtained a State license giving the number of the State License.

3RD: Payment of a sum equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount paid to the Commissioner of Law Enforcement for a State permit to sell retail liquor by the drink.

2ND: THAT he has complied with the 1971 Session Laws of the State of Idaho, as set forth in Chapter 156 of the 1971 Session Laws:

-In the matter of fees for County Retail Wine by the Drink Licenses for 2020: No license for the retail sale of wine by the drink shall be issued to an applicant who does not possess the qualifications set forth in Chapter 13 of Title 23 of the Idaho Code, as amended.

1ST: Make out an application.

2ND: That he has complied with the 1971 Session Laws of the State of Idaho, as set forth in Chapter 156 of the 1973 Session Laws, 41st Legislature.

3RD: That he has obtained a State Retail Wine by the Drink license.

4TH: Fee - \$100.00
