The following proceedings were had to-wit:

Commissioner Hansen attended the Idaho Assoc. of Counties Annual Conference in Boise, ID.

The Commissioners convened at 9:00 a.m. for a Department Head meeting. Those in attendance: Richard Abers/Airport, Jim Cason and Jessica Stutske/Public Works, Keith Chambers/Maintenance, Shelby Heiderman/Weeds, Shannon Atkins/Solid Waste, and Minde Beehner. Items discussed included the following:

- BOCC Public Safety Facility Bond Resolution and Ballot have been completed. New Public Defender Contracts are out for signature. St. Joe garbage/bin collection agreement is out for signature.
- Public Works gave a road and bridge project update. Working on ERF billing packets.
- Weeds Weeds are done for the year and winterizing equipment.
- Solid Waste running out of room for brush, have not received burn permit yet.
- Maintenance elevator has been fixed in the Courthouse. Keith needs to use a Public Works vehicle for winter plowing.
- Planning & Zoning they issued between 20 and 25 new building permits this year. Dan Martinsen is attending a Floodplain Managers Conference in Boise this week.
- Airport Approach lights have been fixed and the gate is finally working well. Richard obtained a new Kawazaki from the Department of Agriculture at no cost. It will be used for plowing.

The Board convened at 11:00 a.m. and the meeting was called to order. The consent agenda was reviewed for consideration as follows:

CHANGES TO AGENDA: A motion was made by Commissioner Fitzgerald, seconded by Commissioner Huber to amend the agenda and add the following; the motion carried. At the request of the Shoshone County Treasurer, Resolution 2019-Certifying Delinquent District Charges to the 2019 Tax Roll Pursuant to Idaho Code 50-1008; and a request from Mile Creek Watershed to certify their

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delinquent charges to the 2019 tax roll. Also added was a request from Columbia Bank for Lease Purchase Agreements/Notice of Intent to Renew.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No public comment was presented.

1. Consideration and Decision of the Minutes of the Commissioners' Public Agenda Session dated Monday, September 16 to Friday, September 20, 2019.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. **Consent Agenda** (These items will be enacted by one motion unless requested by a Commissioner that one of more items be removed for separate discussion.)
  - Beer, Wine & Liquor Licenses
  - Shoshone County Pre-Pays
  - Professional Services Agreement between Shoshone County and Scott Reed, M.D. to provide Medical Program Direction for Shoshone County EMS – term of agreement is October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020 at \$1,500 per month.
  - Resolution 2019-47 Certifying Delinquent District Charges to the 2019 Tax Roll Pursuant to Idaho Code 50-1008
  - Milo Creek Watershed request to certify their delinquent charges to the 2019 tax roll this item was removed for separate discussion.
  - Columbia Bank Lease Purchase Agreements/Notice of Intent to Renew this item was removed for separate discussion.
- 2. Executive Session: Indigent Cases: Consideration and Decision. Executive Session ID Code 74-206(d) Indigent Case # 2019-108/Denied

A motion was made by Commissioner Fitzgerald, seconded by Commissioner Huber to approve the consent agenda as presented with specific items addressed as indicated. The motion carried.

• Milo Creek Watershed Request to certify their delinquent charges to the 2019 tax roll – There is no evidence of the creation or existence of the Milo Creek Watershed District as a governmental subdivision pursuant to Idaho Code Title 42, Chapter 37. Certification of the watershed district is not on file or record with the State Tax Commission. The Milo Creek Watershed District was not one of the nine watershed district's present on the September 2019 list of "State of Idaho 2019 Watershed Districts" published on the State of Idaho

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website. Follow-up inquiries with the Idaho Tax Commission confirmed that the Tax Commission did not have filings or records of the Milo Creek Watershed being petitioned for, formed or functioning as a government subdivision. To this end, certification of delinquent accounts by Shoshone County on behalf of a non-government subdivision is not appropriate and needs to not occur. A motion was made by Commissioner Fitzgerald, seconded by Commissioner Huber to deny certification of delinquent accounts to the 2019 tax roll for the Milo Creek Watershed District. The motion carried.

• Columbia Bank Lease Purchase Agreements/Notice of Intent to Renew – Columbia Bank calls for an annual Notice of Intent to Renew County Leases as follows: Lease #1826799 dated 06/07/2018; Lease #1826804 dated 07-03-2018; Lease #1938426 dated 04-16-2019; Lease #1939241 dated 05-07-2019; and Lease #1939243 dated 05-07-2019. Resolution 2019-38 dated September 9, 2019 adopts the County 2019-2020 fiscal year budget.
