The Commissioners met with David Naccarato with Johnson Controls, Inc. at 9:30 a.m. to discuss and review the history and pros and cons of a Shoshone County Waste-to-Energy Facility. Also in attendance was Josh McDonald with the Shoshone News Press. Items discussed included the following:

- Mr. Naccarato met with the Shoshone County Commissioners in 2008 regarding information on this type of facility, and the purpose of this meeting was for a follow-up visit with updated information on waste-to-energy facilities;
- Research has been done over the past several years, and there are three to four types of waste-to-energy systems that show promise and are viable, feasible systems;
- Cost for this type of facility is in the millions and pays for itself over time;
- The County is not ready at this time cost wise to move forward with the type of facility possibly within the next five to six years it could be a possibility.

The Commissioners met with Dan Martinsen, Shoshone County Planning & Zoning Administrator at 10:00 a.m. to discuss, review and consider a proposed updated Shoshone County Emergency Operations Plan.
