GENERAL PURPOSE

Performs journeyman skills operating light and medium duty equipment to reconstruct, maintain and repair County roads and bridges to ensure that the general public, school buses, commercial transportation and emergency vehicles can travel safely and efficiently in all weather conditions. Occupational field requires long hours of operation in inclement weather and hazardous conditions.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED: Under general supervision of Lead Man, Road Supervisor, and Public Works Director.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED: None

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

- ▶ Performs construction and maintenance on all County roads and bridges including asphalt patching, crack sealing, seal coating, road buildup, shouldering, ditching and culvert installation
- ▶ Performs signing and flagging for traffic control in slide areas and work zones
- ▶ Operates tandem axle trucks, front end loaders and occasionally sander, sweeper and various other related equipment
- ▶ Performs daily vehicle maintenance and servicing and may assist mechanic
- ▶ Fills out daily records concerning job codes, materials, fuel consumption and work orders for cost accounting procedures
- ▶ Twenty four (24) hour "on call" basis
- ▶ May be required to attend approved specialized training classes and seminars
- ▶ Performs related duties as required

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Education and Experience:

- A. Graduation from high school or equivalent; and
- B. Two (2) years experience in the safe operation and maintenance of light and medium equipment; OR
- C. An equivalent combination of education and experience.

2. Related Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Working knowledge of required vehicle operation, maintenance and safety
- Working knowledge of road and bridge technology
- Ability to lift heavy objects in excess of 100 lbs. such as, but not limited to, truck tires, chains and cutting edges
- Ability to perform heavy manual labor tasks
- Must be skilled in verbal communication with the general public

- Must be bondable
3. Special Qualifications:
- Commercial Driver's License of appropriate level and endorsement as prescribed by the State Licensing Division.
