Jason handed out a plan on paper for potential phases the park can use for priority repairs and maintenance as a multiple year plan that also helps with a timeline for Grant funding, or what can be done using volunteer and community members help. The Challenge Cost Share program that the Forest Service and Shoshone County are entering into is almost completed and the next process is what will be the priorities of the first year's repairs and maintenance. Jim See mentioned having a map to visual the layout of the park and use for deciding what repairs should be prioritized, Jason says he can work on providing that at the next meeting. Members of the Pottsville seven will meet again outside of the County and using the phased plan Jason provided, they will review and choose the first year's priorities. Another meeting was scheduled to meet with the Commissioners on March 8, 2022 at 1pm to finalize plans before spring hits.
