

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-19

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF ALLOWABLE EXPENDITURE FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND BUDGET

WHEREAS, Shoshone County received \$2,502,177.00 in American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") grant funding ("Grant") from the United States Department of Treasury (1) to respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") or its negative economic impacts; (2) to respond to workers performing essential work during the public health emergency; (3) to provide for government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue, and (4) to make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure ("Allowable Expenditures"); and

WHEREAS, the revenue loss to Shoshone County, due to COVID-19, which was calculated according to the U.S. Department of Treasury's Interim Rule, and the Board authorized this calculated amount to be set aside for County expenditures that comply with the requirements of funding government services, to the extent of that reduction in revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that designating grant funds to Grant Administration Services and updates to County Facilities to provide for government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue, is an allowable expenditure; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT; that the Board elects the \$2,502,177.00 standard revenue loss allowance, that will be set aside for County expenditures that comply with the requirements of funding government services.
