The following items were discussed:

- Public Works requested an Ordinance be done to address animal control and no dogs allowed in certain Shoshone County parks
- Shoshone County legal assisted in a culmination of changes and additional language based on the complaints that have been received
- PA presented a Draft Ordinance for amendments to County Code Title 5, Chapter 3 labeled Animal Control for the Commissioners consideration
- Ordinance will address animal waste, licensing of dogs, dog license identification, penalties

The PA is still working on the Ordinance, could still be some changes, and will request another meeting be scheduled once the Ordinance is in a final draft form and will want to advertise for a public hearing for the public to attend, and be presented to the Commissioners for approval of amendments to the Ordinance. **10:00 AM** The Board convened to meet with Chris Schwartz to discuss Public Defender Contracts with Shoshone County.

Also in attendance: Chris Schwartz & Matt Beehner

The following items were discussed:

- There is an attorney shortage across Idaho state;
- The County will need to be more competitive to keep attorneys here;
- Historically there has been a 3-5% increase for Public Defender contracts;
- With the two (2) new judges in office, there has been an increase in workload as meetings are now being required to be “in person” hearings;
- With new legislative changes, the state will start paying public defender contracts for the county;
- Chris would like to see a 25% increase across the board for PD contracts because of the workload, which would be a \$76,780 increase, broken down \$32,000 (PD Contracts), \$4500 (Administrative), \$7500 (First Appearance);

The Commissioners will talk it over with Tamie Eberhard, Shoshone County Clerk, and would get back to Chris on the increase. The meeting adjourned.

**2:00 PM** The Board convened for a 22/23 Shoshone County Budget Workshop.

Also in attendance: Shoshone County Clerk, Tamie Eberhard, Chief Deputy Auditor, Angela Dinger, Matt Beehner.

Items discussed included the following:

- Legislative changes
- Justice Levy @ 2%
- Preliminary Budget changes
- \$197,000 over budget, need to cut
- Found items that were able to be cut and now within budget
- Wage increase

Tamie will get the changes made and meeting is scheduled for Monday, August 15, 2022 at 4:00 pm for a final review of budget and approval of the advertising. The meeting adjourned at 3:07 pm.


