A RESOLUTION REVISING THE INSURANCE PREMIUM PAYMENT PLAN FOR SHOSHONE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Shoshone County makes group health insurance benefits available for its employees, and pays a portion of the premiums; and

WHEREAS, the Premium Payment Plan for Shoshone County is designed to provide a participating employee who elects coverage under the Employer's Health Insurance Plan an opportunity to pay for his or her share of the premium on a pre-tax basis instead of paying on an after-tax payroll deduction basis; and

WHEREAS, this plan is intended to qualify as a "cafeteria plan" under Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; and
