Nature & Description of Blight Violation:

The Blight Ordinance requires the following specific conditions to exist to be considered as blight. Which of the following conditions currently exist at or on the property?

- A. Accumulation of garbage, refuse, rubbish, building materials, junk, debris on the property.
- B. Overgrown weeds, unmown grass or the accumulation of brush over eight (8") in height.
- C. Dangerous Building or Structure that is injurious to the public health, safety or general welfare.
- D. Allowing an excavation to remain unguarded by suitable barriers.
- E. Infestation by rodents or other pests.
- F. An animal carcass to remain for a period of time longer than is necessary to remove or dispose of.
- G. Inoperative or unregistered motor vehicles or inoperative boats parked, kept or stored on the premises unless garaged or the premises is properly permitted.
- H. Vacant buildings or structures left unsecured or unguarded against unauthorized entry.
