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10:00 AM Review South Fork Ridge Contract – Bill McLeod

Also, present: Bill McLeod, Matt Beehner

Bill explained this contract is for 6.5 acres. He only received one bid. He is down to one crew, so he wants them to move from their current last project to this one, which will take about two weeks to complete, and then on to Miller's Way up the river to do about 50 acres. He said the bid is lower than they usually come in, they are starting to be more competitive. The bid is for \$19,200 for the 6.5 acres. Commissioner Dose asked why there is only one bid. Bill said the other contractor is no longer in the business. Commissioner Casady asked what the procedure is for advertising. Bill said he doesn't usually advertise for the small projects, its typically word of mouth. He said contractors will usually call him regularly asking about projects, but he hasn't gotten any calls on this one. Commissioner Dose asked where this project is located. Bill said north and south of the airport. He said the cost will be split between a grant this is already open, North Kellogg grant with about \$12,000 left, and the remaining cost will be out of Title III. Commissioner Casady said we like to see more bids but with this smaller parcel this is ok, but in the future we can advertise on the county website for upcoming projects. Commissioner Dose made a motion to approve the South Fork Ridge Contract for \$19,200, seconded by Commissioner Casady. The motion carried. There was no public comment. Bill said he has received a draft memorandum of understanding for a grant he put in for two years ago. They will get about \$195,000 to do work at Miller's Way. He said because it's a draft they want the county to review and ensure everything is correct and agreed upon and then they will send an official MOU for signature. Bill asked if the board would like hard copy or email for review. Commissioner Dose said he can email to the clerk to distribute. Bill said he has been working with Peggy on small changes on reimbursements. There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
