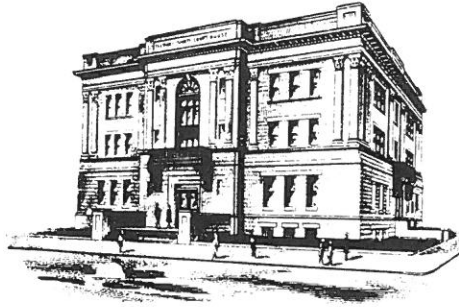

RESOLUTION 2023-14

Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/Dodge Durango/Ford Taurus/Grizzly Lathe & Tools/Bridge/Airport Hanger

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* 31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgement, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, Shoshone County has in its possession two 2011 Dodge Durango's purchased in 2011; and

WHEREAS, Shoshone County has in its possession a 2004 Ford Taurus purchased in 2019; and

WHEREAS, Shoshone County has in its possession a Grizzly Lathe and tools purchased in 2022; and

and WHEREAS, Shoshone County has in its possession a 32 ft x 30 ft modular steel bridge;

and WHEREAS, Shoshone County has in its possession an airport hanger purchased in 2018;

WHEREAS, the estimated total value of the equipment listed above is more than \$250.00; and will go to public auction and;

WHEREAS, Shoshone County desires to have the above-referenced property declared as surplus, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the Count's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the items referenced hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Zimmerman, seconded by Commissioner Casady, the following vote was recorded:




